FLYING TRAINING WEEKEND - HOOD AERODROME, SOLWAY, MASTERTON 6th - 8th April 2018

SITUATION

1SQN is running a flying training weekend at Masterton Aeroclub to further Cadet's
experience of flying and help them towards their aviation goals. Cadets will be able to
consolidate and enhance their skills regardless of what flying experience they have
had.

AIM

2. The aim of this training weekend is for cadets to develop and put into practice aviation skills and concepts they have been taught through their general aviation training.

DETAILS

3. **Date:** Friday 6th April - Sunday 8th April 2018

Location: Wairarapa & Ruahine Aero Club, Hood Aerodrome, Masterton

Cost: Option 1: 1 flight + ex. cost: \$150

Option 2: 2 flights + ex. cost: \$265 Option 3: 3 flights + ex. cost: \$380

ELIGIBILITY

- 4. To attend this activity, the Cadet must not have any outstanding fees/money owed to the Unit.
- 5. New Recruits are not eligible to attend this activity.

FOOD

6. Cadets must bring their lunch for both days. There will be refrigeration available. Dinner and breakfasts will provided over the course of the weekend.

TRANSPORT

7. Transport is provided for the weekend. Drop off and pick up will be from the Unit Building.

TRAINING

8. The weekend will consist of lessons and practical flight training covering the skills and knowledge required for a solo flight.

- 13. Cadets will only fly as much as they have paid for. There will be no option to fly more for more time than the option picked by the Cadet. If the Cadet flies less than they have chosen (due to weather etc), a refund will be issued.
